Fondation Programme in Psychology

Who is this course for?

The Foundation programme acts as a bridge between school leaving qualifications and UK University entry requirements. This is an ideal route onto an undergraduate programme, if you are returning to study after a gap, or if you have not previously studied this subject, or if you did not achieve the grades and hence do not meet the entry criteria you need for a place on a bachelor's degree course programme.

What will I get from this programme?

- Guaranteed progression on to the undergraduate programme in Psychology;
- You will gain the subject specific knowledge and skills required by degree level programmes;
- Our Foundation course is a springboard to successful further degree study and careers in areas such as social services, mental health work, educational sector, counselling and so on.

Career Prospects

On successful completion of the Foundation Year, you will be automatically transfer to the three year BSc (Hons) in Psychology. It is the first step to start a career as a professional psychologist, who works in a variety of fields, such as the clinical sector, management, marketing, education, welfare industries, employment services, industrial relations, and media. We have a dedicated Career Manager Service offering one-to-one coaching and career advice.

Ways to Study

This programme can be completed either face to face or online, part-time or full-time. By studying with us, you will have access to an innovative e-learning platform, where you can review lecture videos, interact with other students through chat rooms and dedicated forums, and find other course-related materials and readings. The e-learning platform is available to you 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, enabling you to flexibly fit studying into your life.
